




Jaipur

India's Pink Jewel

Jaipur is a vibrant and culturally rich city in Rajasthan. The Pink City is known for its magnificent palaces, forts and temples. Its rich history and culture attract tourists from all over the world.

A LESSON IN HISTORY

In the early 18th century, when the kingdom of Amer was facing threats from the Mughal empire, Jai Singh II decided to build a new capital that was located farther away. The new capital was designed by Vidyadhar Bhattacharya and the buildings were made of pink sandstone, which was easily available in the region. Later, the city was named Jaipur after Jai Singh II and was inaugurated in 1727.

KNOW YOUR CITY

Jaipur quickly became a centre of art, culture and commerce after its inauguration. The Pink City is home to many magnificent palaces, forts and temples, all of which were designed in the Rajasthani and Mughal styles. Over the years, Jaipur became a major centre of trade and commerce, as it was known for its handicrafts, textiles and precious stones. The city is also a centre of learning and it is home to several prestigious institutions, including the Jantar Mantar observatory, which was built by Jai Singh II.

TREAT FOR YOUR EYES

Amer Fort - This magnificent fort is located on a hilltop and it offers stunning views of the city. Tourists can explore the palace complex, which includes a museum, gardens and several temples.

City Palace - This magnificent palace complex was the seat of the Maharaja of Jaipur and it includes a museum that showcases the history and culture of Rajasthan.

Hawa Mahal - Also known as the 'Palace of Winds', this iconic building is a popular landmark in Jaipur. Its unique design features a facade with 953 small windows, which were designed to allow cool air to flow through the building.





TANTALISE YOUR TASTE BUDS

Dal Baati Churma - This is a popular Rajasthani dish that consists of lentil soup (Dal), baked wheat balls (*baati*) and a sweet crumbled mixture of wheat flour, sugar and ghee (*churma*).



Ghewar - This is a popular dessert in Rajasthan that is made with flour, ghee and sugar syrup. It is typically served during festivals and special occasions.

Pyaz Kachori - This is a popular street food in Jaipur that consists of a deep-fried pastry filled with spiced onion and potato filling.



TRYST WITH NATURE

Jhalana Safari Park - This park is located in the heart of Jaipur and is home to a large population of leopards. Tourists can take a safari and spot these elusive cats in their natural habitat.

Sambhar Lake - This is India's largest inland salt lake, about 80 km from Jaipur. The lake is a popular spot for birdwatching as it is home to various migratory birds, including flamingos, pelicans, and cranes.

Nahargarh Biological Park - This nature reserve is home to a wide variety of flora and fauna, including tigers, leopards and several species of birds.





Know Your Crew

Gliding towards New Horizons

A big city girl with even bigger dreams—Sakshi Narang, Senior Cabin Crew, talks about how Star Air fulfilled her wish to fly.



What made you choose to become a cabin crew member and what motivates you in this profession?

It was my childhood dream to become a cabin crew member and that's why I put in extra effort to create a comfortable and safe environment for passengers. I'm motivated by the chance to represent Star Air and provide passengers with a genuine service that ensures that they will fly with us again. It's rewarding to know that I'm making a positive impact on their experience.

What do you think are the most important qualities or skills that a cabin crew member should possess?


The most important qualities a cabin crew should have are customer service skills. Cabin crew members represent the airline and are the face of the airline so they should know how to talk with the passengers politely and even firmly depending on the situation. They should also make it a point to learn about the basic things before the mandatory training they receive from the airline.

Were there any challenges you faced during your career and how did you deal with them?

I worked at the Hindon Airport which was a defence airport and we were not allowed to depart a flight after 1730 hours in the evening. On more than one occasion we couldn't depart on time due to operational reasons and because of that, I witnessed passengers miss their final exam or some medical emergencies at their home. During such occasions, I make it a point to remain calm, listen to the passenger and help them in any way I can.

What does an ideal day in your life look like?

When I'm at work, my day starts with a BA test which is a breath analysis

test after which I'm briefed about the flight and informed about important things like my captain, the crew, flight timings and the number of passengers we are expecting in every sector of the aircraft. Before we take off I conduct a few pre-flight checks to ensure all the equipment and services are secured properly at their location.

Can you describe any specific training or certifications you have obtained related to cabin crew duties?

Yes, immediately after I started flying I got an appreciation letter from instructors for my grooming as they appreciated my grooming standards.

Can you tell us about your experience working as a cabin crew member for Star Air?

Working for Star Air as Senior Cabin Crew will always be an unforgettable experience for me as my team members are so good at the ground level as well as in the in-flight department. I never really feel like I am at my workplace because Star Air feels like a family. I started from a customer service executive and Star Air gave me a chance to fulfil my dream. I never thought I would become a Senior Cabin Crew that too in such a short period of time. I have spent four amazing years with Star Air and I hope to continue for many more.★

Dudhsagar Falls Trek, Goa



E175 Proving Flight

Star Air, a leading regional airline, has completed a successful proving flight for its newly acquired Embraer E175 aircraft.



Flight S5 170 departed Bengaluru International Airport at 13:42 hrs on May 9, 2023 and landed at Hyderabad International Airport an hour and fourteen minutes later. The return flight S5 171 departed Hyderabad at 17:03 hrs and landed back at Bengaluru at 18:45 hrs.

The Embraer E175 is a state-of-the-art regional jet with advanced technology, exceptional fuel efficiency; and a spacious cabin that can comfortably accommodate up to 76 passengers. The aircraft is equipped with advanced avionics, including fly-by-wire controls and a glass cockpit, which provide a high level of safety and operational efficiency.

The proving flight was conducted by a team of highly experienced pilots and engineers along with DGCA officials who thoroughly tested the aircraft's performance and systems as well as the airline's procedures, SoPs and compliance with regulatory requirements. The flight demonstration covers all aspects of a flight such as takeoff, climb, cruise, descent and landing, and various flight modes, to demonstrate the aircraft's capabilities in different scenarios as well as operational preparedness of the ground teams in dealing with regular operations as well as contingencies.

Flavours of Mumbai




Dabeli:
